We ar aduertist yat Duncane Oig Patrik Geir Makgregoris and Makpatrik Stewart hes tane our bwhousses¹ and ky of Glenfinlas away and we are nocht assurit quhowyair it be swa or nocht. As concerning Makgregor we beleiff yat he wilbe trew to ws bayth quhowbeid all ye rest of ye Clangregor wald depart fra him for we sall furnis him als guid and better men God willing nor thay ar. And salbe about gif we may to be revenget vpoun yame yat tuik our ky and ye rest of yair compleces. We haif send to Makgregor to stay ye man quhome ze haif lowssit and we sall keip him our self gif he be vnpassit away. Efter ye writing of yir wordis Patrik Makcuill Cleir cam to me and assurit me of ye trewthe for yairis part of geir tane out of Glenfinglas be Patrik Gerr and his breder. And yis is ye first reward yat we haif gottin for our part bot nochtwithstanding sen Makgregor is our awin I cair ye less. And God be with zow. Off Carnastie ye xxiij day of September 1565.
