The Quenis Grace passis nocht hestitlye of yis thowne. And saiffand ze hade grethar effaris instantlie zour presens heir wald expedit and farder zour mater and we wald effectuiscleie yat ze comen for yis and vderis causis lyke as ze sall knew at methin to ye quhilk referris all vder thing. Thus God be with zow of Edinburgh ye saxt day of Merche 1564.
