Desyring zow for yat propos to writt ane bill to me favorablie to propone² the mater to my Lord and Lady Atholl in the quhilk I wald ze schew zour self verray desyrous yairof quhilk bill yairefter I will schaw to my Lord and Lady. Wryting in the same alsua quhatt maner ze desyre the mariage and ... quhatt ze will my Lord and Lady Atholl to do to zow quhatt to thaim and all other sik thing is as ze think maist convenient for yat propos. And by yis alsua I wald ze and the Lady zour wyff subscrived and gaiff over to the Lard of Garntillie and me to propone and bring yat mater to effect with my Lord and Lady quhairin conforme yairto we sall travell and God willing haif good succase yairof. Faryer wald wische zow to ..[eis] with sik convenient speid as ze mycht for the weill of baith the housses as said is. And heirin at lenth to instruct the said Lard of Garntillie of all sik thing as ze think maist necessarrie vat he may mak me partecipant yairof. Yairefter we may propone the mater and bring it to effect schortlie quhairof I wald be verray glad. Sua referring the rest to zour iugement and nixt adverteisment committis zow to the protectioun of God. Frome Blair in Atholl the xij day of August 1570.
