Schir eftir hairtlic commendatioun. I have sene your writtingis quhilk ... send to my Lord of Atholl. Ze may assuir your self of my Lord of [Athollis] ... and the thing he may do for zow and alsua he shall want na eisyn ... be me for zow and your materis. Quhair ze writt to him for the assemble of his folkis to your purpos he is be your letteres zairof warnit at yis tyme yat yairefter ze may be assured of him and all yat he may do for zow to be in reddenes quhan ze will heirefter charge and is als ... in yat mater as ze. I schall sa far as I may contene him in ze gud mynd he is of presentle. And farther if ze will charge me for ony thing yat yis in my poware to do for zow ze schall be assurit yairin be the auld maner as knawis God quho mot haif zow in His keiping. From Blair in Atholl the sevint of July 1570.
