warrant for payment of the Martymes Compt 1577 (sic) to George Fleet

Richt traist freind efter maist hertlie commendatioun. The Comptrollair  
be avise of the Counsale hes maid assignatioun of certane of the  
propertie to the sustentatioun of our hous of the Martinmes terme bypast and  
in tyme cuming amangis the quhilk is zour males of Dischoir and Toyer.  
Quhairfoir we will desyour and pray zow effectuislie that ze will  
caus the Martinmes maill of that lordship be deliverit to the berair  
heirof Archibald Douglas masyour. And yairupoun to ressave our servand George  
Auchinlekkis acquittance quha be ordour of the assignatioun (quhilk ze  
may perceave) is appointit ressaver of the haill. And sua traisting  
that ze will begin the gud paiment that vtheris be zour exemple  
may do the like quhilk we will ressave as acceptable plesir at  
zour handes. Committis zow in the protectioun of Almichtie God.  
At Edinburgh the xxij of December 1572.
