And swa be avise of ye saidis nobilitie and estates His Maiesteis parliament is proclamit to be haldin in ye Tolbuith of Edinburgh ye fyftene day of Januare nixtocum ffor confirmatioun of ye present regiment and other materis yat salbe proponit tending to ye avancement of Godis glorie and ye commoun weill and quietnes of ye cuntrie. Quhairfore we will desire and pray zow effectiuslie that ze substantiouslie accumpanyit with zour freindis and servandis will adres zow to be in Edinburgh ye said xv day of Januare that be zour presence avise and concurrence ye said parliament may ye bettir proceid to ye effect abovewrittin. As yairby ze will gif declaratioun of zour constant gud will and mynd to ye obedience and suirtie of our said Soverane Lord and commoun weill of yis our native cuntrie and will do ws very thankfull and acceptable pleasir. Sa we commit zow in ye protectioun of God. At Edinburgh ye penult day of November 1572.
