Thairfor now gif he agreis vnto ye assurance ze salbe assuret yair sall na thing be callit be law induring that spaice in zour contrair. And we salbe reddy to meit vpoun xij dayis warnyng in ony plaice before ye assurance pas out at quhat tyme we sall taik ordour in that thing betuix zow and zour sone Doncane. Forder in all thinges we refer vnto ye berar and committis zow in ye protectioun of ye Allmytie. Frome ye Pallece of Hallerudhous the vij of Fabrouer 1580.
