Formulating your own title







Identify the general area you want to write about.

Focus: Angle or viewpoint on the subject. What aspect of the subject is your assignment about?

Limits: Restrictions on the subject matter. What, in specific terms, is your assignment about? Dates? Case studies?



Research:

Reject some topics!

- Not sufficiently interesting.
- Difficult to resource.
- Too wide.

Is it relevant to the course?

Check your:

- Lecture notes.
- Resource/reading lists.



Refine the wording of the title

Comment: You could use an instructional word or phrase. For example 'an evaluation of' or 'comparison between'.



Get the wording approved if necessary.

Leave enough time for this.
